INTRODUCTION

Ansty & Staplefield Parish Council recognises the importance of providing a website that is available to the widest possible audience. We are committed to making our website accessible to everyone, including blind or partially sighted visitors who use screen readers. We will continue to be proactive to increase the accessibility and usability of our website in conjunction with current government guidelines in order to make it a user friendly experience for everyone, regardless of ability.

WEBSITE ACCESSIBILITY REGULATIONS 2018 AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES:

Legislation

The Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018 requires public sector bodies, which includes local councils, to ensure reasonable adjustments are made to websites so they are accessible to people with various disabilities. These include:

- Impaired vision
- Motor difficulties
- Cognitive impairments or learning disabilities
- Deafness or impaired hearing

Ansty & Staplefield Parish Council will continue to ensure its website is accessible, in accordance with these regulations.

This website is run by Ansty & Staplefield Parish Council. We want as many people as possible to be able to use this website. For example, that means you should be able to:
